- Good Morning! To start our tour we are going to visit the ancient city of Mdina.
  - Mdina is a fortified city located in the central part of the Mediterranean island of Malta. Also known as the "Silent City," Mdina is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world, dating back to the 8th century BC. The city is characterized by narrow streets, alleyways, and historic buildings, many of which were constructed during the medieval period. The city's walls, which date back to the 9th century, are still standing and offer impressive views of the surrounding landscape. One of the most notable features of Mdina is the Baroque-style St. Paul's Cathedral, which was built in the 17th century. The cathedral features ornate decorations, including marble floors, gilded ceilings, and intricate paintings. Another popular attraction in Mdina is the Mdina Dungeons, which offer visitors a glimpse into the city's dark past. The dungeons were used as prison cells during the medieval period and are now open to the public as a museum.

- 🛱 From Mdina we will make our way to Ħaġar Qim
- 🗇 Visit Ħaġar Qim & Mnajdra Archaeological Park
  - Ħaġar Qim dates from circa 3600 3200 B.C. It stands on a hilltop overlooking the sea and the islet of Fifla. Set
    in a hollow above the Southern cliffs, and only 500 metres away, lies the contemporaneous temple site of
    Mnajdra. The surrounding area is typical of Mediterranean garigue and is designated a Heritage Park. An
    adjacent visitor centre complements the visit.
- Depart for the Dingli Cliffs
- 🔊 Visit to the Dingli Cliffs
  - The Dingli Cliffs offer stunning panoramic views of the Mediterranean Sea and the surrounding countryside. Visitors can walk along the edge of the cliffs and take in the breathtaking views of the sea and nearby landscapes. In addition to its natural beauty, the Dingli Cliffs are also of historical importance. The area has been inhabited since prehistoric times, and there are several archaeological sites in the surrounding areas, including the prehistoric cart ruts and tombs. The area also played a significant role in the defense of Malta during World War II, and visitors can see several military fortifications and gun emplacements along the cliffs.

  - O Pompeii was an ancient city located in what is now the comune of Pompei near Naples in the Campania region of Italy. Pompeii, along with Herculaneum and many villas in the surrounding area was buried under 4 to 6 m of volcanic ash and pumice in the Eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD. Largely preserved under the ash, the excavated city offers a unique snapshot of Roman life, frozen at the moment it was buried although much of the detailed evidence of the everyday life of its inhabitants was lost in the excavations.
